- The Supreme Audit Institutions (SAIs) have as their main function to assess the proper use of public resources, as well as the effectiveness and efficiency of public policies.
- They can carry out compliance, financial, and performance audits in relation to climate financing.
- SAIs are not responsible for designing or implementing public policies, but rather for evaluating government action.
