



Practical Information - SAI20 Senior Officials Meeting (SOM) - 2024

Objective:

The Senior Officials Meeting (SOM) is the technical discussion forum of SAI20, the Supreme Audit Institutions (SAI) engagement group of the G20 member countries. The SAI20 SOM is a preliminary event leading up to the Annual SAI20 Summit, which the SAI of the G20 host country organizes. This event offers a unique opportunity to discuss topics of interest and relevance to these institutions with the necessary depth and broad participation of SAIs.

The third edition of SAI20 SOM is scheduled to be held in Brasília, Brazil, on **April 15 to 18**.

April 15: Participants arrival, delivery of badges and participant kit, from 10 am to 7 pm (Venue: Hotel Grand Mercure Brasilia - Eixo Monumental)

April 16 and 17: Meetings

April 18: Brasília City Tour

The event will feature technical discussions on Climate Financing and Energy Transitions and the Fight Against Hunger and Poverty. These topics were selected following the G20 agenda and the priorities of the Brazilian government during its G20 Presidency.

SAI20 aims to provide practical policy recommendations that can benefit SAIs in their work on the chosen themes. These recommendations will also have the potential to influence G20 discussions. The participating SAIs will discuss the draft of these recommendations in the form of a Communiqué during the SAI20 SOM. Following this, the heads of the G20 SAIs will meet at the SAI20 Summit, scheduled to be held in **Belém, Brazil, on June 16, 17, and 18**, to discuss further and approve the final version of the Communiqué.
